We will speak to the class about journeys we have been on, talk about our own knowledge of transport and think about the questions we might like to ask to people who use or operate transport. We will use role play to co-operatively run bus stops, train stations, travel agents and much more!

Maths

We will make links with measuring length, weight and capacity when looking at different modes of transport. Through our transport role play we will begin to talk about money and think about the route and direction vehicles take. We will try to locate numerals within the transport world and look at areas of transport that interest us to begin to solve mathematical problems based on them.

Literacy

We will read books such as:

- Journey by Aaron Becker
- You can't take an elephant on the bus by Patricia Cleveland-Peck
- Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers

We will create our own adventure stories and write simple postcards after being on an adventure story journey. We will use our phonic knowledge to label vehicles and look at transport poems to develop our rhyming skills.



Expressive Arts and Design

There will be the opportunity for children to explore different materials in order to create our own transport for different animals. There will be lots of exciting role play areas for the children to explore, including our own bus stop and travel agents. Our weekly dance session will also focus on different modes of transport! We will be learning to sing lots of songs about transport and create our own 'On the Move' music.

Understanding the World

We will look at the timeline of some vehicles and talk about how things change over time. We will investigate significant historical figures such as Emilia Earhart, Christopher Columbus, the Wright Brothers and George Stevenson. We will use different modes of transport to travel the world and discuss similarities and differences between ourselves and others. We will also use a range of technology to create our own vehicles.

Communication and Language

We will be looking at a different mode of transport every fortnight and thinking about questions such as when we would use them, where we would go or who would use them. We will talk about transport that helps us, such as ambulances and fire engines and talk about our own experiences of using transport. We will also be listening to a wide range of stories about transport and responding to questions about the text.

Physical Development

We will be doing Real PE with Miss England who will be teaching us different ways of moving and travelling and our dance sessions will also be linked to different modes of transport. We will develop our independence when changing for PE and think about the importance of exercise for good health.

We will link our Dough Dancing to transport and ensure the continuous provision for developing our tool handling is linked to our topic as well.
