


KEY INFORMATION FOR OAK AND ASH PARENTS/CARERS

SEPTEMBER 2020



Children to walk into school through normal school gate, At the end of the day parents will walk onto playground and go out the normal end of school way past the library. See map and markings on playground.
 In the morning- Year 1 and 2 can be dropped off at the gate where they will walk into class.
 For the first few days Miss Dooley would like Reception parents to come onto the playground to meet you and carry out some school settling in activities with your child, as normally you would be invited into class which we can't do this year. This will be for 10 minutes from 8:50-9am and socially distanced weather permitting.
 We also request that as parents you do not congregate after drop off/pick up of your child.
 When waiting at the end of the day to collect we ask you stand a sensible distance apart from other parents and carers on the playground and ensure small children aren't playing on the equipment

If you need to come to the office, please use the tape markings which will be marked 2m apart to socially distance appropriately. • If your child is ill <u>in anyway</u> then please do not send them in to school. • If anyone in the school becomes unwell with a new and persistent cough or a high temperature, or has a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia), they must be sent home and advised to follow 'stay at home: guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus infection', which sets out that they should self-isolate for at least 10 days and should arrange to have a test to see if they have coronavirus. If they have tested positive whilst not experiencing symptoms but develop symptoms during the isolation period, they should restart the 10-day isolation period from the day they develop symptoms. Other members of their household (including any siblings) should self-isolate for 14 days from when the symptomatic person first had symptoms • If the test is negative and they are feeling better then they will be allowed back into school. If positive, the whole bubble or class may need to close and this will be communicated by text and email.
