I have explored Transport in Oak class with a focus on Bicycles. I entered a Hurricane in Birch class where they were using their senses to explore a Hurricane experience. Finally, today I was part of the Viking Long boat design teams in Elm where perseverance and precision was needed!

Also this week I had some training from an Ofsted Inspector about the new framework and expectations. As a school we have worked very hard on our Curriculum design for a while now so whilst we do have work to do and changes to make not as much as other schools!
